FASTBREAK BASKETBALL LEAGUE RULES - ENTRY FEE: \$375.00

All current VHSL Rules will be observed along with the following modifications and/or changes: The Recreation Center is a family oriented, recreational facility. Abusive language or behavior, intimidation tactics, trash talking and overall unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated by any patron, participant, player, referee, manager, coach or spectator during the particular program or during any other program or activity sponsored or hosted by this facility or the Radford Parks and Recreation Department.

LEAGUE RULES

1. Substitute players must enter the game by reporting to the scorer's table. These players must remain seated at the table and are not to obstruct view of scorekeepers.
2. Only players and the team manager and league officials are allowed to sit in the team bench area and shoot baskets during warm-ups and at half time. All others will not be allowed on the floor.
3. Technical fouls count as personal fouls and team fouls.
4. All bench fouls including roster violations and substitution violations count as team fouls and team technical fouls.
5. Each team will be allowed five technical fouls. Any team receiving a 5th technical foul will be suspended from league play for the remainder of the season. All player technical fouls count as team technical fouls.
6. Each Player will be allowed 3 technical fouls. Any player receiving 3 technical fouls will be suspended from league play for the remainder of the season.
7. No jewelry, this includes medical tags, bracelets, and necklaces.
8. Team managers/captains must be announced to officials before the game begins. This is the team spokesperson during the game and is the only individual who will be allowed to discuss game rules and other matters regarding the game. This does not give this person the right to act unruly, berate officials, etc.
9. Any ejected player must leave the building and parking lot within two minutes of time of ejection. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of game by the ejected player's team.
10. Radford City Police may be called upon for security and whenever necessary for preventive measures. Those individuals that the police are called for are subject to suspension from league play for a year from point of occurrence.
11. While any player or team is suspended from league play, he/she/they will not be allowed on the property of game site during league game times. He/she/they will be considered as trespassers and will be prosecuted accordingly.
12. Any player disqualified for fighting during league play, warm-ups and pre/post game time periods will be suspended from this and all Radford City Recreation Facilities for one year. (Fighting includes, but is not limited to, swinging or attempting to land a punch, kick, push or bite as well as landing a punch, kick, push or bite.)
13. Anyone that strikes any league official (such as referees, scorekeepers, supervisors, full or part time employees of the City of Radford), or prevents them from performing their assigned tasks (such as using the phone to contact police), or threatens bodily harm or retaliation will be suspended from all Radford Recreation Department programs and facilities for a period to be determined by the Director of the Recreation Department.
14. Players and managers are not permitted to discuss, argue, or disturb scorekeepers. If there is a problem with the scorekeeper, managers or team spokesperson are to bring matter to the attention of the referees.
15. A team must floor at least four players at the scheduled time of game. There will be a five-minute grace period from start of game time. In the event that a team was to floor only four players and one of the four were to foul out, they may continue with only three players, and so forth to two players. The opposing team is allowed to floor five players against such a team if they desire.
16. Games will consist of two, 20-minute halves with the clock running except during time-outs. The clock will be stopped for the last two minutes of the second half. There will be a five minute halftime.
17. Teams will receive two time-outs per half and time-outs may not be carried over. One time-out during overtime will be allowed.
18. Teams must supply their own jerseys. All jerseys have to match with same color numbers on back of jerseys. You will not be allowed to play in games if you do not match your team's colors.
19. Players must be 18 years of age as of the first game, and cannot be a member of any college or professional basketball organization. They must also be out of high school.
20. The Radford Parks and Recreation Department shall have the authority to take disciplinary action against any manager or player for misconduct before, during, or after the game.
21. **BLOOD RULE:** A player, coach, or official who is bleeding or who has blood on his uniform shall be prohibited from participating further in the game until appropriate treatment can be administered. If medical care or treatment can be administered in a reasonable length of time, the individual will not have to leave the game. The length of time that is considered reasonable is left to the referee's judgment.
22. **PROFANITY RULE:** Any use of profanity on or around the playing area, before, during or after the game, by any player or manager, coach or fan will result in a technical foul and automatic ejection from the game or the gym.
23. Players, coaches, managers and spectators are reminded that this is a recreational league being played in a family-oriented recreational facility. Unruly and unsafe behavior or intimidation and abusive behavior will not be tolerated.
24. **TRASH TALKING RULE:** Any comments made to the opposing teams, fans, players or managers, officials, scorekeepers or league officials that are viewed by the referees as unsportsmanlike, derogatory, or personally intimidating or abusive will be treated as profanity and will be penalized as such (see rule #25).
25. If a game is tied at the end of regulation, one 3-minute overtime will be played. If the game is still tied at the end of overtime, a sudden death period will be played with the first team scoring by goal or free throw being the winner.
26. **Each player, coach, and manager must sign the accompanying player contract form, which will signify awareness of the above rules. By signing the accompanying player contract form, each player, coach and manager agrees to abide by each of the above rules and agrees that the Radford Parks and Recreation Department has the authority to enforce each of the above rules.**
27. **FINE RULE:** Any player receiving an unsportsmanlike technical foul will be fined \$10.00. This must be paid before they can play their next scheduled game. A second technical foul will cost a player \$25.00. Third technical foul will suspend a player for the rest of the season and a \$50.00 fine. Players receiving fines will not be allowed to use the Radford Recreation Center until their fines are paid.
28. Teams up by 25 points or more cannot shoot from the 3-point line. Any player breaking this rule will be called for a technical foul.
