RAIN / LIGHTNING POLICY: Team coaches umpire their own games. Should parents or coaches see lightning or hear thunder, all players need to go to their cars. Teams must wait 30 minutes from last lightning strike before players can return to the field. Second strike after waiting 15 minutes, games will be cancelled. Coaches should use good judgment when playing games in the rain. Game days when raining, a decision will be made by the Recreation Department by 3:00 p.m. Parents may call the Recreation Department after 3:00 p.m. to find out a decision on the games.

TEEBALL RULES

PLAYING FIELD: The playing field is the same as an official little league baseball field. The only addition is an arc extended across the infield from a point 18-feet down the first and third base lines. Fifty-foot baseline.

RULES:

1. Players take regular baseball field positions. A player assumes a position of the pitcher, but does not actually pitch. He is simply another fielder in that position. There is also a catcher who assists in placing the ball in the tee for the batters. All other players may be placed in the outfield. Player's positions should be changed each inning. The same children should not always play the infield/key positions.
2. The fielders must be situated outside the 18-foot radius of home plate when the batters hit the ball. The pitcher position must stay in front of the pitching mound, but not on either side.
3. A ball must be hit in fair territory beyond the 18-foot line to be in play. A hit ball that does not go beyond this line is considered a foul ball.
4. The ball is hit off the tee situated at home plate. Each player is permitted three swings to hit the ball off the tee and beyond the 18-foot arc. The ball must be hit clearly. A swing that strikes the rubber part of the tee is considered a foul ball regardless of how far the ball goes.
5. The infield fly rule is not followed and no tagging up on fly balls is permitted.
6. Batters are not permitted to steal or lead off bases. If this occurs, the players are to be called out. Batters are not permitted to bunt or swing easy at the ball. If this occurs, the batter is called back to home plate and charged with a strike.
7. Once the play has been completed on a batter, the ball is returned to the catcher who places it on the tee for the next batter.
8. Every player of each team bats each inning, and the inning is over when the last youngster bats. Both teams and all youngsters that appear to play must be placed on the batting roster and must bat in the order they appear on the lineup. The first inning the players will bat from the top of the roster down, the second inning the players will bat from the bottom up, and the third inning from the top down. No score is kept.
9. Each game will be three (3) innings in length.
10. No game will start with less than eight players on either team. A five-minute grace period will be allowed before a forfeit is called. A scrub game with all players present will be played, but the game will not count.
11. All games will have a one-hour time limit.
12. Coaches are allowed to stay on the edge of the outfield to assist the players on offense. Two coaches are allowed in the outfield during play.
13. The umpire is in complete charge of the game and all decisions are final.
14. In case of a game in progress being rained out, two full innings constitute a complete game.
15. In case of an over-throw, a player may advance one base only.
16. Teams will umpire their own games.
