GENERAL GUIDANCE:

ENTERING FACILITIES -

CHRISTIANSBURG - When entering facility all participants and spectators will enter at Main gate after they have received notification from site supervisor. Once Site Supervisor has notified the coach, the coach will notify their team when it is time to enter the stadium. At the completion of game, the team and spectators must exit doors gate by the new field house back to the parking lot.

All participants and spectators waiting for game will need to wait in your car and then you will be notified when to enter the facility by the Site Supervisor. No one is allowed in the stadium until notification occurs.

Participants and Spectators should not show to parking lot more than 30 minutes before game time.

Radford - All fans must sit on the bank or around scoreboard endzone. No one will be allowed on the Riverside sideline. Family members may sit together, all others must be at least 6 feet apart.

All participants and spectators waiting for game will need to wait in your car and then you will be notified when to enter the facility by the Site Supervisor. No one is allowed in the stadium until notification occurs.

Participants and Spectators should not show to parking lot more than 30 minutes before game time.

Everyone must wear a face covering when entering the Football Facilities. All spectators must wear a face covering at all times. All participants must wear a face covering into facilities and out of facilities. Will not need to wear face covering when playing in the game or practicing, must wear a face covering when standing on the sidelines. Coaches must wear a face covering at all times.

GAME OPERATIONS AND OFFICIALS GUIDANCE:

Pre-Game captains meeting:

- * Social distancing of six feet between individuals must be implemented during all pre-game meetings between referee and team manager or coach. No players should be part of meeting.

Games and Practices:

- * Only 4 spectator will be allowed per participant and they must sit in the designated seating area with face coverings. Must also practice social distancing while in the facility.
- * Allow time between practices and games for cleaning and disinfecting.
- * If player, coach or spectator test positive for COVID - 19 the NRV Health District contact tracers will handle notifying anyone with exposure. This will not be handled through the Parks and Recreation Departments.

ON - FIELD GUIDANCE:

No Handshakes/Personal Contact Celebrations:

- * Players and coaches should take measures to prevent all but the incidental contact necessary to play the game. This should include refraining from handshakes, high fives, fist/elbow bumps, chest bumps and group celebrations.
- * Players should vacate the facility as soon as reasonably possible after the conclusion of game.
- * If back to back games, teams cannot enter facility until last game participants and spectators have left the area completely. The Site Supervisor will contact the coach and the coach will contact team players on when to enter.

Drinks and snacks:

- * Players, coaches and staff should bring their own personal drinks. No public water fountains will be in use.

Sidelines:

- * Coaches and players must be at least six feet apart.
- * Players must wear face coverings when on the sidelines..
- * Coaches must wear face coverings at all times.
- * Hand wipes and/or sanitizers will be at the entrance of facility and sidelines.

Player Equipment:

- * Teams will need to disinfect footballs during and after all practices and games.
- * No personal player's equipment bags will be allowed.
- * Player's should not share towels, clothing, or other items that they may use to wipe their face and hands.
- * No personal football allowed.

STAY HOME:

In order for us to play and continue to play the entire season, all players, coaches and spectators should stay at home if they have tested positive or been contacted by NRV Health District contact tracers as possible exposure candidate for a minimum of 14 days. Should stay at home if not feeling well or displaying any of the following symptoms:

Chills	Shortness of breath	Diarrhea
Coughing	Sore throat	Vomiting
Runny nose	Headaches	Loss of taste or smell
Fever or running a temperature over 100 degrees
